Notulen jaarvergadering 9 maart 2019.

1. Opening by the chairman.

Aletta welcomes everyone. Present are 3 board members and 17 members. René has to work and Frans has broken his arm, so they are not here today. Also absent with notification are the gentlemen Van Laar, Vonk and Wildeboer. A minute's silence will be held in memory of the deceased Members Ad Boks and Mr Speek.

2. Minutes of the previous meeting 10 March 2018.

Be approved and Bram is thanked for making it.

3. Set agenda.

Agenda is approved.

4. Documents and communications.

Bas is thanked for making the club magazine. In 2019, the young animal day

was on October 12th. In 2020, this will be a week earlier, namely 3 October. The AVG form (this is about privacy legislation) has not been sent back by everyone, the members in the meeting have no objection. By e-mail about 10 requests for animals come in, these people are helped to animals. Further invitations from the Dutch Grouse Club and SZH (Stichting Zeldzame Huisdieren = Foundation of rare domestic animals). Hendrik and Aletta will attend the meeting of SZH on 23 March. The WUR (Wageningen University & Research) is looking for animals with abnormalities.

At the national shows, few of our club races were on display. On Oneto (in Enschede) only a few big Blues of Hendrik and at the Noordshow (in Assen) also only 3 big Blues and 5 bantams (Noord-Hollandse krielen). Maybe we should think about a club show in the middle of the country. The problem is that many shows are held at the same time. Hanno Dijkhorst says that the registration fee in the Netherlands is relatively low. According that the registration fee in the Netherlands is relatively low. Bas wants to set up a working group of Assendelfters together with Piet Rol and Simon Hondius. Jan de Wit asks if SZH (Stichting Zeldzame Huisdierrassen = Foundation for rare domestic animals) should be reported on how worrying the situation is at the moment.

15. Any other business

Jan de Wit has two questions: can we inform members if measures on bird flu are lifted. And can a loose leaf be put in the club magazine in memory of dues.

Gerard Tesselaar thanks the board that he has been allowed to judge the animals. He also wants to give the members a compliment because they are very nice to get on with.

Annual Report 2019 by secretary and chairman

Board

The board held a board meeting at the Noordhow in Assen on 4 January. Discussion points included the organization of the general members meeting and the young animal day, various reports, incoming and outgoing documents, the finances, pricing schedule and website. Because not all board members could be present, the general members meeting of March 2019 was co-prepared with the help of telephone and e-mail. What was discussed at the general members meeting of Saturday 9 March 2019 you can read in the minutes (elsewhere in this club magazine). During this general members meeting René v/d Kerkhof and Frans Assendelft were retired and both were re-elected.

The website is managed by the secretary and the chairman. In case of calamities and disturbances, an external support can be remanded in the case of emergency and failures. Because there are costs associated with this support, this is only used in the utmost necessity. Young animal day

The young animal day of 12 October 2019 in the clubhouse of AKV in Amersfoort went well. The board was particularly pleased with the large turnout and the fact that, after a long time, there was again a nice number of animals in the cages. During this one-day inspection, the judges Johnny Wever, Ide Meijering and Hanno Dijkhorst assessed 123 animals (18 Assendelfters, 33 North Dutch Blues and 72 North Dutch bantams). There was a cosy atmosphere and there was a lot of chatter between the cages. Since the Wyandotte club also had the young animal day with us, it was a buzz of buzz. One advantage of this was that the lottery had a nice yield.

Proposal textual adjustment down colour in standard North Dutch Blue for both large and bantam

It has been noticed that the standard text - and then mainly the colour description at the North Dutch Blues both with the large ones and the bantams - can be more detailed in order to achieve better breeding results, the description of the down colour can be clearer. The proposals for changes/additions are shown in the text below from the standard in italics.

Colour stroke: Cuckoo

Colour and drawing of the rooster

Each feather is on dark blue-grey ground colour, three or four times slightly arched crossed by a light blue-grey drawing, which is not tightly bounded. In the ornamental feathers, the number of transverse bands is larger in relation to the length of the feather. In those feathers, but most in the neck and saddle feathers, the drawing tends towards an inverted V. The cuckoo drawing should be clear and as even as possible over the whole body. *The down colour is light (blue) greyish to white, preferably no striping.*

Colour and drawing of the hens

The hen is generally drawn as the rooster, but shows darker because the cross bands at the hen are slightly narrower *and the end of the feather ends with a dark blue-grey cross band. The down colour is light grey to blue grey, with as little striping as possible.*

Serious errors

Far too dark or far too light colour. Completely miscoloured feathers; strong yellow or rust-brown tint in the ornamental feathers of the rooster.

Errors

Slightly too light or slightly too dark colour; some miscoloured feather sections; a clear striping in the down feathering.

Animal parade Noordshow 2020

There was a disappointing number of animals of our breeds at the animal parade of the Noordshow 2020. By 5 breeders (of which 4 of our club) were registered to 18 animals. Three Assendelfters Zilverpel, three North Dutch Blues and twelve North Dutch bantams. René v/d Kerkhof won the 1F at the North-Dutch bantams, both with the roosters and with the hens. René congratulations on this result.
